

Terminology - Stock

Current Stock

This list applies to units which are currently in the business. These terms are used throughout the CMS and the POS.

Label	Purpose
Stock	<i>Total number of units in the business</i> <i>Includes Available, Reserved and Unavailable</i>
On Hand	<i>Number of units held at the current Store</i> <i>Includes Available, Reserved and Unavailable</i>
Available	<i>Number of units available for Sales Order fulfilment in the User's current Store</i> <i>This equals On Hand minus Reserved and Unavailable</i>
Reserved	<i>Number of units Reserved to Sales Orders and eCommerce baskets</i> <i>Includes all Sales Order lines which have not been despatched, and excludes orders with the following statuses:</i> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Draft• Quote (unless 'reserve' manually toggled)• Abandoned• Cancelled <i>Also includes units of stock in locations marked as 'Reserved'</i>
Unavailable	<i>Unavailable units, typically damaged or undergoing quality control</i> <i>Number of units held in locations marked as 'Unavailable'</i>
Available Elsewhere	<i>Number of Available units elsewhere in the business, e.g. the total amount of Available units in other Stores</i>

Purchase Orders

This list applies to units which are currently on order from a Supplier. These terms are used throughout the CMS and the POS.

Label	Purpose
On Order	<i>Total number of units ordered from the Supplier</i> <i>Typically, this is in relation to the total number of units ordered from a Supplier on a particular Purchase Order</i> <i>This equals 'Allocated' plus 'Unallocated'</i>
Allocated	<i>Total number of units on a Purchase Order allocated to Sales Order lines</i> <i>This equals 'On Order' minus 'Unallocated'</i> <i>This figure includes units on 'Locked' Purchase Orders</i>
Unallocated	<i>Total number of units on a Purchase Order that are free to be allocated</i> <i>This equals 'On Order' minus 'Allocated'</i> <i>Units on a 'Locked' Purchase Order will be excluded from 'Unallocated'</i>

POS

This list includes labels which are only used within the POS.

Label	Purpose
Available to order	<i>Signifies that there are no units of the SKU within the business, and that there are none on order - fulfilment of a new Sales Order will only be possible following a Purchase Order</i>
Backorder lead time is xxx days	<i>Displays the default lead time for the SKU</i>

eCommerce

This list includes labels which are only used within the eCommerce website.

Label	Purpose
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In Stock	<p>Signifies that there are units available in the business, and that a new Sales Order may be immediately fulfilled</p> <p>An 'In Stock' figure is made up of the total number of Available units in Locations across all Stores enabled for web fulfilment.</p>
Out of Stock	<p>Signifies that there are no units available in the business, and that a new Sales Order may be will not be fulfilled</p> <p>An 'Out Of Stock' figure is determined by checking the total number of Available units in Locations across all Stores enabled for web fulfilment.</p>
Available (allow XXX days for delivery)	Displays the default lead time for the SKU
Low Stock	<p>Signifies that there are only a small number of Available units</p> <p>Triggered if the number of 'In Stock' units is less than the 'Low Stock (order at)' figure on the Inventory tab</p>
Available to pre-order	<p>Signifies that stock is coming into the business, which will be used to fulfil a new Sales Order</p> <p>The appropriate lead time will be displayed in the checkout</p> <p>Only displays if 'allow back order' is not enabled</p> <p>Total number of units available to pre-order equals the total amount of 'unallocated' units for that SKU across all Purchase Orders</p>

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
